70/19 Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received from Councillors G Bird and P Sloan and Borough Councillor P Sloan.

71/19 Declarations of Interests

Cllr Dalton, as a member of Chorley Council's Development Control Committee, declared a non-pecuniary interest in agenda item 5 (Planning Matters).

72/19 Minutes of the Meeting held on 8 July 2019

Resolved: the Minutes (as circulated) were approved and signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

74/19 Planning Matters

19/00625/FUL Erection of calf rearing building, with internal access road and hardstanding at Roecroft Farmhouse, Ulnes Walton Lane. As this follows an outline application for an agricultural worker's dwelling on the same site, concerns were expressed regarding the erosion of the Green belt.

Resolved: an objection, on the grounds of unacceptable erosion of the Green belt by this development, is to be submitted.

As a result of a resident's objection to the proposed location of the westbound sign, a revised location slightly closer to the 30mph sign had been proposed by Lancashire County Council following approval by the Highway Engineer. The resident is to be provided with details of the revised location. Councillors were in agreement with the revised location.
