01/20 Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received from Cllr G Bird.

02/20 Declarations of Interests

Cllr Dalton, as a member of Chorley Council's Development Control Committee, declared a non-pecuniary interest in agenda item 5 (Planning Matters).

03/20 Minutes of the Meeting held on 9 December 2019

04/20 Public Participation

Concerns regarding the condition of the road surface along Holker Lane, believed to be caused by heavy vehicles, were raised. This is to be reported to Lancashire County Council.

A query on the planning permission for the Land at Forge Cottage was raised. Clarification on development in the Green belt will be sought from Chorley Council Planning Officers.

The difference in cost of the Chorley Council grey recycling bins, as compared to South Ribble, was raised. It was pointed out Chorley Council is holding council tax this year, whereas South Ribble is proposing an increase.

The lack of hardstanding at bus stops on Ulnes Walton Lane was mentioned, together with the entrance signs on Ulnes Walton Lane and Leyland Lane. These issues are to be raised at the Neighbourhood Area Meeting.
